Exhibitor Terms and Conditions

The exhibit space includes (1) 10 x 10 tent, (1) 6 ft. table, (2) chairs, and an identification sign.

Excludes: Electrical, internet and audiovisual services and connections, which are available for a fee from the venue's exclusive provider.

Cancellation by Exhibitor: All cancellations must be in writing and shall become effective when received by The Korean Society of Maryland. Both the Exhibitor and The Korean Society of Maryland acknowledge that The Korean Society of Maryland will sustain substantial losses if the Exhibitor cancels this contract. Even though The Korean Society of Maryland will exercise its best efforts to mitigate the damages associated with the Exhibitor's cancellation, the parties agree that The Korean Society of Maryland will nevertheless incur substantial losses that cannot be precisely determined. Accordingly, Exhibitor agrees to waive all related future claims and to pay to The Korean Society of Maryland a non-refundable fee of 100% of the contracted exhibit space cost for canceled exhibit space.

Attendance: The Korean Society of Maryland makes no representations or warranties with respect to the demographic make-up, volume of exhibitors and/or number of attendees at this event.

Exhibit Space Assignments: The Korean Society of Maryland will, in its sole discretion, assign appropriate exhibit space according to the system implemented for the event. Exhibitors may request specific table assignments and The Korean Society of Maryland will make a reasonable effort to accommodate the requests. The Korean Society of Maryland further reserves, in its sole discretion, the right to move or reallocate Exhibitor's table space to a new location in the interest of a better showing of the exhibit, for the betterment of the overall exhibit hall, or for any other reason deemed necessary by The Korean Society of Maryland.

Exhibit Signs, Decorations, etc.: Exhibitors are solely responsible for the safety and security of their exhibits and property. All construction, displays, decorations and signs must conform to The Korean Society of Maryland and venue regulations (upon request, Exhibitor shall provide a written description).

Electrical, Cleaning, Catering Services, etc.: For insurance, safety and security purposes, electrical, internet, cleaning, catering, rigging, carpeting, furniture, drayage and other services needed by individual Exhibitors are provided only when the Exhibitor orders and pays for these services from the exclusive supplier(s) authorized to provide such services. The Korean Society of Maryland shall not be responsible or liable for these services. Exhibitor must provide electricity surge protection devices for its exhibit table and equipment.

Liability: Exhibitor agrees that The Korean Society of Maryland, co-sponsoring organization(s), the venue, its owner and its management company, and their respective employees and agents are not liable for any theft, damage or loss to or of the exhibitor's property or for any injury that may occur to the Exhibitor, its agents, employees, guests or business invitees. The exhibitor assumes the entire responsibility and liability for losses, damages, and claims arising out of exhibitor's activities in the venue premises or at the event and will indemnify, defend, and hold harmless The Korean Society of Maryland, the venue, its owner, and its management company, as well as their respective agents, servants, and employees from any and all such losses, damages and claims.

Event Cancellation: The Korean Society of Maryland reserves the right to cancel or postpone this event at any time without any liability for the fulfillment of this contract, and all fees paid by Exhibitor shall, in the sole discretion of The Korean Society of Maryland, be refunded. The Korean Festival event is RAIN OR SHINE.

No Show: Any Exhibitor that fails to erect and staff a display in their assigned table by the scheduled opening of the exhibit hall shall be considered a no-show and shall forfeit all fees paid.

Governing Law and Jurisdiction: This contract shall be governed by and subject to the laws of the State of Maryland and all matters, whether sounding in contract or in tort, relating to the validity, construction, interpretation and enforcement of this contract shall be heard in an appropriate Court of the State of Maryland, which shall have exclusive jurisdiction and venue.
